A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING <u>PROTECTION FOR COLORADO RESIDENTS FROM FEDERAL</u>
102 <u>GOVERNMENT OVERREACH BASED ON A PERSON'S STATUS.</u>

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill prohibits a state or political subdivision:

- From providing the <u>race</u>, <u>ethnicity</u>, <u>national origin</u>, immigration status, or religious affiliation of a Colorado resident to the federal government for any illegal or unconstitutional purpose;
- From aiding or assisting the federal government in

- creating, maintaining, or updating a registry of Colorado residents based on <u>race</u>, <u>ethnicity</u>, <u>national origin</u>, immigration status, or religious affiliation;
- From aiding or assisting the federal government or a federal agency in marking or otherwise placing a physical or electronic identifier on a person based on <u>his or her race</u>, ethnicity, national origin, <u>immigration status</u>, or religious affiliation; and
- From aiding or assisting, including using state or local lands or resources, the federal government in interning a person based on his or her <u>race</u>, ethnicity, national origin, <u>immigration status</u>, or religious affiliation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. The general assembly 3 hereby finds and declares that Colorado has been a beacon of hope 4 against inhumane practices, such as the internment of communities. 5 Colorado is called to lead again against the potential overreach of the 6 federal government. The Colorado general assembly is aware that history 7 often repeats itself. History has demonstrated that the demonization of 8 communities leading to internment camps and the deprivation of human 9 rights, constitutional rights, and civil rights are often rooted in the 10 overreach of federal policies. The Colorado general assembly rejects any 11 federal attempts to demonize Colorado communities, rejects any attempts 12 to detain or intern Coloradans, and rejects any attempts to access data or 13 information about Coloradans for illegal or unconstitutional purposes. 14 Through its constitutional reservation of powers, Colorado will prohibit 15 the use of state and local law enforcement and state and local resources to engage in discriminatory and unconstitutional behavior that is 16 17 repugnant to Colorado values. In asserting its constitutional reservation 18 of powers, the Colorado general assembly affirms its obligation to prevail 19 over federal overreach that may result in Coloradans being harmed.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** article 76.6 to
